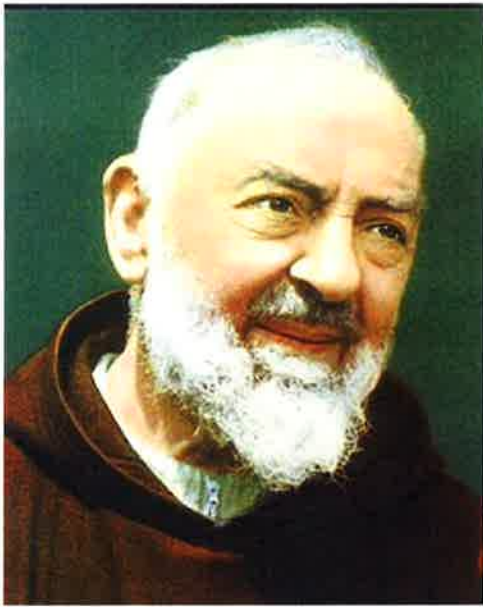

## 50th Commemoration Anniversary of the passing of St Padre Pio and the 100th Anniversary of the emergence of his stigmata

St. Pio, an Italian-born Capuchin friar was known for having heavenly visions. He was drawn to religious life at the age of 10 after hearing a Capuchin speak. At age 15 he entered the Capuchin Franciscan Friars, and was ordained a priest in 1910. In September, 1916 he was assigned to the Friary in San Giovanni Rotondo in central Italy, where he lived for the rest of his life.

St. Padre Pio is said to have the gifts of healing, bilocation, levitation, prophecy, miracles, and abstinence from sleep and nutrition. His stigmata emerged during World War I, after Pope Benedict XV asked Christians to pray for an end to the conflict. While hearing confessions, Padre Pio had his first occurrence of the stigmata: he had a vision in which Christ pierced his side. A few weeks later, on September 20, 1918, Jesus again appeared to him, and he received the full stigmata. News of this gave hope to the local Catholics after World War I. Stigmata is the term the Catholic Church uses to speak about the wounds an individual receives that correspond to

the crucifixion. They can appear on the forehead, hands, and feet.

For several years the Vatican denied the gifts, and refused to allow Pio to celebrate Mass. In 1933, Pope Pius XI reversed the Vatican's position. Pio was later credited with curing the cancer from a friend of then Pope John Paul II, who canonized him in 2002. Stigmata remained with him until his death on September 23, 1968.

Today his tomb in San Giovanni Rotondo in central Italy is the most visited shrine in Europe, surpassing even Fatima and Lourdes—a place of extraordinary holiness for those in search of inspiration.

### **PRAYER (Novena/Litany)**

In honor of St Padre Pio and his suffering we celebrate his life. He has taught us to "Pray, Hope and Don't Worry" as "Worry is useless" and that "Prayer is the best weapon we have; it is the key to God's heart." Through his intercession we ask for our prayers to be answered by God. After Jesus ascended to Heaven, Mary, the Apostles, and other devoted disciples prayed constantly for nine days. Catholics pray nine-day novenas to show honor to various saints and to God. Based on this, beginning Sunday, September 23rd, our parish community will pray a nine day novena in honor of St. Padre Pio.

Copies of all the prayers used will be available at the church. The Novena/Litany prayers will take place at the end of each Mass during the celebration. **The Litany will continue to be said on the 1st Wednesday of each month beginning October 3rd after the 7:00pm Mass.**

### **SEPTEMBER 30th**

The statue of the Holy Family from St. Patrick's in Wheatville, (where it stood in a grotto until it's closing) is being relocated outside the Oakfield church by the generous donation of Ron & Bernice Hochmuth. On this special occasion, the statue will be blessed before Mass, with the Novena/Litany recited at the end of Mass.

**A light luncheon to celebrate these St Padre Pio anniversaries will follow in the parish hall, everyone is invited.**

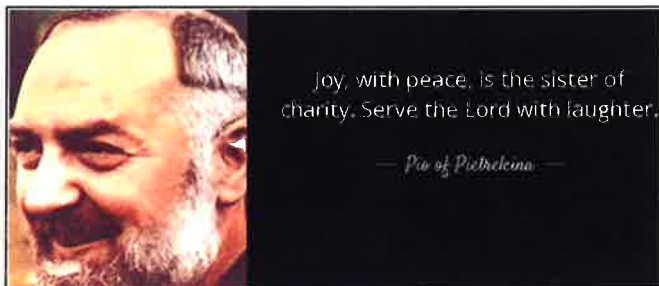
