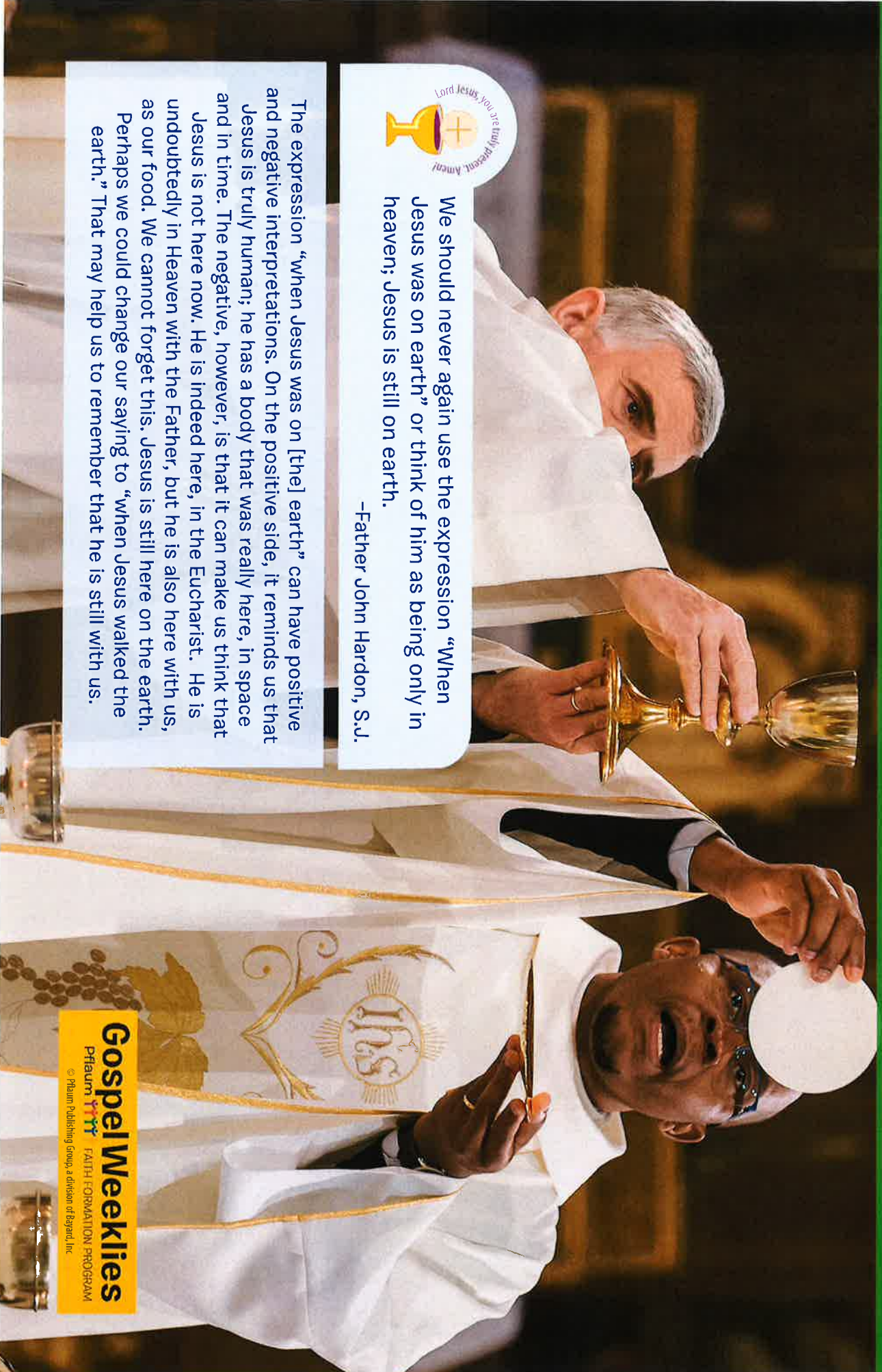

Lesson 6 • October 23, 2022 • 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time



We should never again use the expression “When Jesus was on earth” or think of him as being only in heaven; Jesus is still on earth.

—Father John Hardon, S.J.

The expression “when Jesus was on [the] earth” can have positive and negative interpretations. On the positive side, it reminds us that Jesus is truly human; he has a body that was really here, in space and in time. The negative, however, is that it can make us think that Jesus is not here now. He is indeed here, in the Eucharist. He is undoubtedly in Heaven with the Father, but he is also here with us, as our food. We cannot forget this. Jesus is still here on the earth. Perhaps we could change our saying to “when Jesus walked the earth.” That may help us to remember that he is still with us.
